

Occupational Health Testing Protocol

Associates with Exposure to or Symptoms of COVID-19

If at all possible, when symptoms or exposure develop at work, associate should be screened and tested **prior to being sent home**

Potential Exposure or Symptoms Identified

Associate calls Occupational Health Call Center (open 6 am to 12 midnight)

A clinician in the Occupational Health Call Center will **administer the screening tool** for COVID-19 and **determine necessity for testing**. At this time, COVID-19 testing is reserved for symptomatic associates.

General testing criteria for associates:

- Symptoms include any of the following: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea

***Exposure** is close contact (within approximately 6 feet for prolonged periods of time) with a COVID-19 positive patient or PUI without the use of recommended personal protective equipment.

- High-level exposure** is defined only as household contact with a person who is confirmed COVID-19 positive.
