Person Under Investigation (PUI) Status Removal Guide After a Negative Real-Time COVID-19 PCR
\*\*PRIMARY TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR WRITING THE DISCONTINUATION ISOLATION ORDER\*\*

Purpose: Guidelines for attending provider decision making when considering discontinuation of PUI status in the setting of a negative COVID-19 PCR test.

Table with 5 rows of assessment questions and a final summary row. Questions include: 1. Does the patient have ONE of the following symptoms? (fever, cough, shortness of breath, etc.); 2. Does the patient have hypoxia/hypoxemia or interstitial infiltrates on CXR?; 3. Does the patient have absolute lymphopenia less than 1000?; 4. Is the patient a BMT, SOT, have an active malignancy, HIV, or on immunosuppressing agents?; 5. Does the patient have a known contact with a patient confirmed to have COVID-19? The final row asks: Does the patient have 2 or more of the above criteria or unable to answer questions 1&5? with NO and YES options.
